

Scholarship programme to support student publishing activities

(in the wording effective from 1st September 2019)

In accordance with § 28 section 1 of Act No. 111/1998 Coll. on Higher Education Institutions and on Amendments and Supplements to some other Acts (the Higher Education Act), as amended (the "Higher Education Act"), I hereby issue this Measure:

Article 1

Scholarship programme specification

The scholarship programme to support student publication activities is one of the scholarship programmes of the Faculty of Law, Masaryk University (hereinafter referred to as "the faculty"), and according to Art. 3, par. 1, letter b) of Masaryk University Scholarship and Bursary Regulations is issued by the dean.

Article 2

Purpose of the Scholarship Programme and its duration

1. The purpose of the scholarship programme is to support publication activities of students in doctoral study programmes at the faculty in form of peer-reviewed scientific in category Jimp, Jsc of Jost, paper in proceedings in category Dsc and Dimp or in form of scholarly books in category B and chapters in scholarly books in category C (hereinafter referred to as "publications").
2. The scholarship programme is open for the academic year 2019/2020. Should there not be announced different duration of the programme by the end of the abovementioned period, i.e. the programme is not abolished, the effect of the scholarship programme is prolonged by another academic year.
3. The scholarship constitutes award for the work on the publication and is supposed to motivate students to further publication work.

Article 3

Eligibility for the Scholarship Programme

1. A scholarship within this Scholarship Programme can be awarded to students enrolled in a doctoral study programme regardless the study form.
2. Publications must meet requirements of the methodology for evaluating research organisation and research, development and innovation purpose-tied aid programmes issued by the Government of the Czech Republic.
3. Publishing a publication in one of the formats listed in Art. 2, par. 1 of this measure is an obligatory condition for the scholarship award. In exceptional cases, a

publication accepted for publishing may be accepted. In this case, a confirmation of publication acceptance issued by the publisher must be submitted.

4. Publication of a scholarly book may be financed from the faculty budget. Such a publication must be reviewed and published in a renowned publishing house with editorial board. The vice-dean for science and research is authorized to award this financial support based on the student's application and his/her supervisor's recommendation.
5. The fulfilment of requirements conducted according to Art.3, par. 2 of this Measure are verified by the head of the faculty library or a person appointed by him/her.
6. Financial support according to this measure will not be awarded in case the student's publication proposed for the scholarship award has been financed from other public sources (e.g. specific research project, excluding projects aimed at monograph publishing, GAČR project, TAČR project etc.), alternatively from private sources (excluding author's royalty).

Article 4

The amount of the scholarship within the Scholarship Programme

1. The amount of the scholarship awarded is:
 - a) the amount for a peer-reviewed article in category Jost: 1 000 CZK – 3 000 CZK according to the scholarly quality and extent;
 - b) the amount for a peer-reviewed article in category Jimp: 6 000 CZK – 8 000 CZK according to the scholarly quality and extent;
 - c) the amount for a peer-reviewed article in category Jsc: 3 000 CZK – 5 000 CZK according to the scholarly quality and extent;
 - d) the amount for a scholarly book in category B: 5 000 CZK – 10 000 CZK according to the scholarly quality and extent;
 - e) the amount for a chapter in a scholarly book in category C: a share of the amount for the whole scholarly book, given by the ratio of the number of pages of the chapter to the number of pages of the whole scholarly book;
 - f) the amount for a paper in proceedings in category Dsc or Dimp: 3 000 CZK – 5 000 CZK according to the scholarly quality and extent;
2. The scholarship is financed from the faculty scholarship fund.

Article 5

Scholarship proposal and the amount awarded

1. The scholarship is awarded by the dean based on the student's application submitted by his/her supervisor. The application must be submitted at latest:
 - by 31st August for publications published in the first half-year of the given calendar year
 - by 31st January for publications published in the second half-year of the preceding calendar year.

2. The application for the scholarship pursuant to this measure must contain (vide the annex):
 - a) required information in the application;
 - b) statement of the supervisor on the scholarly quality and extent of the publication;
 - c) supervisor's proposal of the scholarship amount and a comment;
 - d) statement of the executive assistant on compliance with Art. 3, par. 2 of this Measure.
3. Submission of the publication in the repository of MU is an obligatory condition for the scholarship award.
4. If the publication has not been published yet, pursuant to Art. 3, par. 3 of this Measure a confirmation of publication acceptance issued by the publisher must be submitted together with the application.
5. The text of the publication must be submitted together with the application for the scholarship. In case the publication is available in an electronic version, a link to that version is sufficient.
6. The scholarship is payable pursuant to Art. 16 of Masaryk University Scholarship and Bursary Regulations.
7. In case there are more student co-authors of the publication, the scholarship is divided according to the mathematical share of each author.

Article 6

Final provisions

1. I hereby authorize the Vice-dean for doctoral studies and advanced Master's state examinations with implementation of this Measure, its conduct and its possible amendments.
2. I authorize the Vice-dean for Science and Research to interpret the individual provisions of this Measure.
3. This Measure replaces the Dean's Measure No. 12/2018.
4. This Measure comes into effect on 1st September 2019.
