

**Measure of the Dean of the Faculty of Law, Masaryk University No. 8/2019**

## **Scholarship programme to support student club and other activities**

(in the wording effective from 3<sup>rd</sup> May 2019)

*In accordance with § 28 section 1 of Act No. 111/1998 Coll. on Higher Education Institutions and on Amendments and Supplements to some other Acts (the Higher Education Act), as amended (the "Higher Education Act"), I hereby issue this Measure:*

### **Article 1**

#### **Scholarship programme specification**

The scholarship programme to support student club and other activities is one of the scholarship programmes of the Faculty of Law, Masaryk University (hereinafter referred to as "the faculty"), and according to Art. 3, par. 1, letter b) of Masaryk University Scholarship and Bursary Regulations is issued by the Dean.

### **Article 2**

#### **Purpose of the scholarship programme and its duration**

1. The purpose of the scholarship programme is to support student club activities that aim at development of reciprocal, especially international cooperation of student clubs and organizations (typically various university student club members' gatherings). The scholarship programme is intended to directly support student clubs and organizations of 30 members at minimum (hereinafter referred to as "the clubs"), the function of which at the Faculty of Law influences the overall faculty life and the activity of which contributes to the increase of academic environment quality.
2. The scholarship programme is furthermore intended to support development of reciprocal cooperation of the Academic Senate and academic authorities of other universities.
3. The scholarship programme is also intended to support student journals publishing within the MU academic environment that are connected to the Faculty of Law

activities. The scholarship is an award for organization help or an authorship of an article published in the journal.

4. The purpose of the scholarship programme is not to support events such as conferences, summer schools or student competitions.
5. The scholarship programme is open for the academic year 2018/2019. Should there not be announced different duration of the programme by the end of the abovementioned period, i.e. the programme is not abolished, the effect of the scholarship programme is prolonged by another academic year.

### **Article 3**

#### **Conditions for the scholarship award**

1. A scholarship within this Scholarship Programme can be awarded to students of Bachelor's, Master's or doctoral degree study the faculty regardless the study form.
2. The scholarship pursuant to Art. 2, par. 1 and 2 can be awarded to a student who is a member of a given student club or the Academic Senate and who took part in an event fulfilling requirements pursuant to Art. 2.
3. The scholarship pursuant to Art. 2, par. 3 is awarded as an expression of appreciation of remarkable initiative of the student that is directly connected with organizational activities in publishing of the given journal or an authorship of an article published in the journal.

### **Article 4**

#### **The amount of the scholarship and the financial source**

1. The scholarship pursuant to Art. 2, par. 1 and 2 is, as a rule, awarded in the amount of the participation fee and valid costs of accommodation and public transportation fare. Specific student club or the Academic Senate is eligible to obtain the amount of up to 100.000 CZK in the given academic year, proportionally divided into terms.

In exceptional cases, the dean may increase this amount based on the nature of supported events and significance of the student club activities.

2. The scholarship may be awarded in a single sum or in instalments.
3. The scholarship is financed from the faculty scholarship fund or other sources currently intended for this purpose.

## **Article 5**

### **Scholarship application and scholarship payment**

1. The scholarship pursuant to Art. 2, par. 1 and 2 is awarded by the Dean based on the student's application. The application includes:
  - a) name and surname of the applicant
  - b) university ID number
  - c) Title, place and date of the event
  - d) data on the organizers, incl. web page link if available
  - e) the amount of the participation fee or a similar fee and the amount of other costs (accommodation and fare)
  - f) the amount of the scholarship applied for
  - g) declaration of honour on the event participation (or confirmation of participation, if it has been issued)
  - h) recommendation of the chair of the student club or the Academic Senate to award the scholarship, including the significance of the event for the student club or the Academic Senate activityAnnexes of the application are original receipts or invoices proving the amount and details of the costs.
2. The scholarship pursuant to Art. 2, par. 3 awarded by the Dean based on the proposal of the editor. The proposal includes:
  - a) name and surname of the student
  - b) university ID number
  - c) title of the journal
  - d) the scholarship amount proposal
  - e) description of the student's activities
  - f) reasoning of the scholarship amount.The proposal is not binding for the dean.

## **Article 6**

### **Final Provisions**

1. I hereby authorize the Vice-dean for Bachelor's degree study and follow-up Master's degree study in case of Bachelor's degree students, the Vice-dean for doctoral studies and advanced Master's examination procedure in case of students of Theoretical Legal Sciences study programme and the Vice-dean for Master's degree study in other cases, with implementation and conduct of this Measure. I entrust them with power pursuant to Art. 2, par. 1, Art. 4, par. 1 and Art. 5.

2. I hereby authorize the Vice-dean for Master's degree study with interpretation of individual provisions of this Measure.
3. This Measure enters into force on 3<sup>rd</sup> May 2019.

This Measure replaces the Directive No. 5/2017 from 1<sup>st</sup> September 2017.
