- Artificial Intelligence – Theoretical and Practical Legal Problems;
- Use of Artificial Intelligence in Law – Liability and Protection of Rights;
- Managing the Risks Associated with Artificial Intelligence within Societies and Organisations.

CALL FOR ABSTRACTS:

An abstract (up to 500 words with no more than 5 keywords) should be submitted with the application form.

Accepted abstracts (in relation to whom conference fee has been paid) will be published in the Book of Abstracts.

CALL FOR PAPERS:

Authors of accepted abstracts have the opportunity to submit a full paper (in English) of no more than 10,000 words (including tables and references), which will be reviewed by at least two reviewers. After a double blind review, the accepted papers will be categorised (as a original scientific paper; preliminary communication; review article; professional paper) and published in a electronic edition which will be sent for indexation.

CONFERENCE FEE:¹

Publication of Abstract + Presentation (onsite or online) with or without Publication of Full Paper: 200 EUR

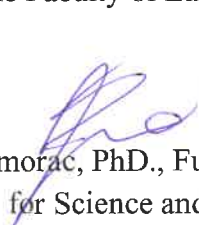
